Pam Wells' email regarding Council's description of Sanctuary Point, on Council's website. Pam critical of the description. Alan Krause advised that Sanctuary Point Pride agreed with Pam's comments, and the Pride has discussed with Council, improvements to the Sanct Pt description.

Email from Paul Dohery. Some Forum members were perturbed about wording of the email; implies that Council may not be intending to involve Community in all planning stages for the proposed official wetland reserve in Larmer Avenue. BVF EXPECTS that community WILL be consulted at all stages of the process.

School footpaths. Mark Kitchener's email: *There are two path projects in the draft budget one at Tallyan Point road near the school at Basin View (\$110 000) and the other at Idlewild Ave opposite the school entrance at Sanctuary Point (\$50 000). These haven't been adopted by Council but are proposed for next year."*

Paradise beach foreshore concept plan: Forum will send another letter, if not dealt with at Nat Resources meeting on 21st May.

Advise from Council of Jessica Rippon, as Community Engagement Officer, noted as a positive step.
