- **Traffic issues** in Tahnee / Vost, e.g. cars being run-off into ditches.

- **Pedestrian Crossings in Paradise Beach Rd.**

Forum believes that the crossing outside the School on Paradise Beach Road should remain a school crossing despite the school's non involvement in placing flags at the site. With the enormous growth in housing on the Western side of Sanctuary Point where the homes are currently being built and settled, the pedestrian traffic from this side of the road is increasing at a rapid rate.

Anson Street DA & RA

Update presented by Narrell & Maureen. Letters have been sent to Planning Minister.

JRPP had an onsite meeting here last week.

Council has now a full-time consultant to investigate the height variation.

Question raised: Why was Cllr Levett absent from the JRPP meeting.

2nd letter from Cllr Proudfoot was presented to meeting.

Toilets: Clifton Community Garden Committee has lobbied for toilets at the 'Learn to Ride' facility. Last school hols proved the need for it.

Steps at Blacket Park, Rauch Close, St Georges Basin are very eroded, making access to water difficult. Has now become a safety issue.

Trail Bikes/Wool Lane: Trail bikes have become an increasing problem using The Wool Lane reserve; down from Anson St, across Annabell Place, down to Wool Road land. Need bollards and/or boulders. Weekends and school hols are worse.
